Exploring Biology is a one-credit seminar designed to help you consider future careers and investigate possibilities in the biological sciences. During the first part of class we will explore the major areas of biology and consider what it is that biologists actually do for a living. In the later parts of class we will have UW Alumni guests from different career areas who will discuss their job and career trajectory and answer student interview questions. Students will work individually and in groups to prepare questions for the speakers and complete short weekly assignments.
